- ▶ Clean & Affordable Energy Act (2008)
- ▶ Ratepayer-funded, nonprofit operated

 \$20 million budget in FY 2014
 Delivering \$105 million in ratepayer
 benefits
 <12% program administration costs

- ▶ Designed to help District households, businesses, and institutions **save energy and money through energy efficiency and renewable energy programs.**




DCSEU Goals

- ▶ Create green jobs for District residents (88 FTEs)
- ▶ Stimulate the local economy (35% local business spending)
- ▶ Reduce energy use throughout the District (1%)
- ▶ Improve the energy efficiency of housing for low-income residents (30% low-income spending)
- ▶ Reduce growth in peak demand
- ▶ Increase renewable energy generating capacity
