



### **OPC LEGAL INTERN – SUMMER 2017**

The Office of the People's Counsel (“OPC” or “Office”) is an independent agency of the District of Columbia government that advocates for consumers of natural gas, electric, and telephone services. The Office is a party to all utility-related proceedings before the District of Columbia Public Service Commission. Additionally, OPC represents the interests of District ratepayers before District courts, federal courts, and federal regulatory agencies.

OPC seeks a rising second or third-year student to join its Litigation Services Division for a paid internship during summer 2017. The Legal Intern may be asked to undertake some or all of the following tasks:

- Research federal and District statutes and regulations;
- Analyze legal issues relating to the electric, natural gas, and telecommunications industry;
- Draft memoranda summarizing research results and analysis of legal issues;
- Draft and review various pleadings for DC Public Service Commission proceedings;
- Draft discovery requests and review discovery responses;
- Assist with filings for federal regulatory agencies; and
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
