

**DETERMINATION AND FINDINGS
FOR
SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT**

1. **Authorization**ⁱ

2. **Minimum Need:**

The Office of the People's Counsel request the services of DataNet Systems Corporation to develop and implement an e-Invoice Tracking System.

3. **Estimated Fair and Reasonable Price:**

\$10,000.00

4. **Facts That Justify a Sole Source Procurement:**

- A. The Office of the People's Counsel "OPC" is an independent agency of the District of Columbia government. By law, it is the advocate for consume of natural gas, electric and telephone services in the District. District of Columbia law designates the Office as a party to all utility-related proceedings before the public Service Commission. The Office also represents the interests of District ratepayers before federal regulatory agencies. The Office is authorized to investigate the operations and valuation of utility companies independently of any pending proceedings.
- B. DataNet Systems Corporation is a Certified Business Enterprise technical services company with headquarters in Washington, DC providing quality technical and management solutions for commercial and government web-based application systems and software integration for communications and networking applications
- C. DataNet Systems Corporation has developed and implemented e-invoice Tracking Systems for District of Columbia Government agencies which perform the task identical to the needs of OPC. OPC has previously worked with Data Net Corporation in connection with website and IT matters.

D. Due to DataNet Systems Corporation’s extensive prior work with OPC in connection with IT matters, their District of Columbia Department of Small and Local Business Development CBE status and prior experience with developing identical software applications for the District of Columbia government, it is recommended that a sole source contract be award to DataNet Systems Corporation.

ⁱ Procurement authority is vested in the Commission pursuant to § 13 (c) (2) of the Residential Real Property Seller Disclosure, Funeral Services Date Change, and Public Service Commission Independent Procurement Authority Act of 1998 (D.C. Law 12-263). The Commission is statutorily exempt from the D.C. procurement rules as set forth in D.C. Official Code § 1-1181 et seq.

DC Law: 34-804, hereby established within the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia, has established by DC Law: 34-801, an office to be known as the “Office of the People’s Counsel”. The office shall be a party, as of right, in any investigation, valuation, revaluation, or proceeding of any nature by the Public Service Commission of or concerning a public utility operating in the District of Columbia.
